Warren County Department of Fire and Rescue Services is a combination fire and rescue system supported by approximately 125 active volunteers and a career staff of 32. We cover a total land area of 213 square miles.

Get your fingerprints taken after you fill out the application and turn it into your fire and rescue company. Here's how:

For fingerprinting, [visit this link](#) and follow the prompts to sign up for fingerprinting. Choose Non-certified, even if you have fire certifications or are a certified driver. Certified EMS applicants must hold a provider license as an EMT-B or higher. On the second screen, highlight and copy the proper Fieldprint Code listed in item number 4. Set up an account and schedule fingerprinting. Warren County's VAOEMS agency code number is 943.

Applicants **must make an appointment online** because walk-ins are not accepted. The closest fingerprinting location in Warren County is **The UPS Store 7189, 424a South Street, Front Royal, VA 22630**. They are open 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday through Friday and 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday.
