- All Explosive Use and/or Blasting Operations Permits shall require the payment of an application fee of \$100.00 per application request made payable to the Warren County Department of Fire and Rescue Services.
- 2) All Explosive Use and/or Blasting Operations applications should be filed with the Department of Fire and Rescue Services within ten (10) calendar days of explosive use and/or blasting operations, unless under emergency conditions which shall be approved by the Fire Chief and/or Fire Marshal.
- 3) A site plan drawing shall be provided with the application for explosive use and/or blasting operations and shall note any effected structures, roadways, above/below ground utilities, etc.
- 4) Pre-blast surveys shall be completed on any effected structures, roadways, above/below ground utilities, etc.
- 5) A site inspection shall be performed with the Fire Marshal and/or Designated Individual prior to any blasting and/or explosive use activities.
- 6) Blast records shall be kept in accordance with SFPC Section 3307.16 and made available for inspection by the Fire Marshal's Office representative upon request.
- 7) Any airblast and/or ground vibration generated as a result of the functioning of the explosives shall be within limits established in NFPA 495-06 as referenced in the Statewide Fire Prevention Code.
- 8) All flyrock will be confined to the defined blast site as required by the Statewide Fire Prevention Code.
- 9) In accordance with SFPC Section 3307.1, only a Virginia SFMO certified blaster shall conduct or supervise blasting operations. A copy of blasting operator's valid certification card shall be submitted with the application.
- 10) Agricultural Exemption to certification: As provided for in SFPC Section 3301.2.4.1, individuals conducting agricultural blasting on their own property (five (5) or more acres devoted to agricultural or horticultural use) are exempt from certification as a Blaster but, each applicant must still comply with §27-97.2 of the Code of Virginia by having undergone a criminal history records check.
